With an undeniable calling into sports, he grew from an unpaid intern with the Red Wings into the youngest GM in Triple-A ball.

Under Dan's direction, the Rochester Red Wings have been nationally honored for their high-level, consistent performance (Ongoing Excellence Award), long-standing excellence of ballpark and front office operations (Ballpark Digest, the Baseball America Triple-A Bob Freitas Award), and in recognition of outstanding promotions (Larry MacPhail Award). Dan has been honored three times as International League Executive of the Year: 1996, 1997 and 2012. He is the past president of the Rochester Press Radio Club and a former board member of McQuaid Jesuit High School, Hillside Family of Agencies and Compeer.
